

NGO taking interest in producing solar panels

Karachi: Professor Dr Richard Komp has dedicated his life to educate the people in underdeveloped poor countries such as, India, Bangladesh, Nicaragua, Africa etc in Solar Module developing. He is the world well-known solar energy professional and the Director of a US based NGO Sky heat Association. Dr Komp in Pakistan with the help and efforts of Faizan Ahmad, student of College of Engineering, University of Dayton USA, therefore, Galaxy of Youth and a Government registered NGO, structured one month training session in recent times for unemployed young people. Twenty students who belong to the poor families enrolled for the training. Some students were from Swat, Swabi, Muzaffarbad etc.

The main objective of this mission is to provide a poor group of about 20 aggravated workers in Karachi, an opportunity for profitable employment, through their participation in a PV workshop, which is organize by Dr Richard Komp. The month-long training trained the students on local manufacturing of Solar Panels. The workshop will train a unit of "solar engineers" to design, manufacture, install and retain solar electric home systems for the inhabitants of Karachi. The range of the project is not just limited to the preliminary workshop, but includes ensuring the long-term sustainability of these business enterprises through the establishment of a help of the workshop participants, or the setting up of a social enterprise.
